

Drywall Masonry Adhesive 100

Gyprock Drywall Masonry Adhesive 100 is a simple and convenient way to adhere plasterboard sheets to masonry and concrete walls. It is specially formulated for Western Australian conditions and to offer excellent adhesion properties with an extending 100 minute working life once mixed.

Recommended Use

Drywall Masonry Adhesive 100 is supplied as a dry powder with easy mixing and application properties. It is used for adhering plasterboard to masonry and concrete surfaces, suitable for use in bigger projects that require mixing large batches.

Important

- Drywall Masonry Adhesive 100 is not suitable for use on wet area plasterboard in tiled areas.
- Do not mix Drywall Masonry Adhesive 100 after setting or drying has commenced.
- When mixing only use clean domestic water.
- Fresh batches of cement must be kept free of previous batches, or the working life will be shortened.
- Do not add water after mix begins to thicken and harden.
- Remove paint from any surfaces where Drywall Masonry Adhesive 100 is to be applied.
- Ensure surfaces are free from oil, grease or other foreign materials before use.
- Always use clean containers and equipment

Storage

Store plaster in a dry place. Do not place bags directly on concrete floors or damp ground. Long term storage may affect the plaster setting time and finish quality.

Mixing

Pour Drywall Masonry Adhesive 100 powder slowly into water and mix to a firm creamy consistency. Use the proportion of approximately 3kg of powder with 1.5 litres of water. It is ideal to let mixture sit for 5 minutes prior to use, although mixture can be used immediately. This adhesive has a working life of 80-100 minutes. Do not mix more material than can be used 80 minutes.

Application

This information applies to non-fire rated interior walls. Leveling pads should be used where irregularities in wall surface exceed 15mm. Apply 15mm diameter daubs of adhesive standing out a minimum of 15mm. Space daubs at 450mm vertically and horizontally to the wall or back of the plasterboard. Space daubs 50mm in from the ends and edges of the sheet. Position boards and use a straight edge to tamp the boards into alignment, both vertically and horizontally. Hold the boards in position until adhesive sets. Alternatively, if a 'solid wall' effect is desired, apply Gyprock Drywall Masonry Adhesive 100 over the entire board surface with a 10mm x 10mm notched trowel before positioning and aligning.

Installing to Standards AS/NZS2589: Gypsum linings – Application and Finishing outlines the procedures for jointing and finishing of Gyprock plasterboard in conjunction with additional details contained in Gyprock Technical Literature.
