

# **Gyprock Casting Plaster**

Gyprock Casting Plaster is used for the manufacture of plasterglass, fibre-reinforced plaster sheets, cornice and general casting applications. This plaster is grit free and produces a strong moulded product with a clean cast face. It is a low VOC plaster manufactured by Gyprock in Australia to stringent product specifications and packed in a dark blue coloured bag.

## **Recommended Use**

Gyprock Casting Plaster is used in the manufacture of fibre-reinforced plaster products, in which fibre glass rovings are laid into the plaster slurry during casting for added strength. The product has a simple 'mix and pour' process, suitable for general casting work and making it ideal to create custom details in both ceiling and wall applications in residential and commercial projects.

## Important

- Gyprock Casting Plaster has an initial set of approximately 25 minutes.
- Any moulds should be cleaned and coated with a release agent where possible.
- Use only clean domestic water.
- Mixing equipment must be thoroughly cleaned after each mix.
- Fresh batches of Gyprock Casting Plaster should be kept free of previous batches, otherwise the working life will be shortened.
- Gyprock does NOT recommend casting parts of the body (fingers, hands) with Casting Plaster. Casting Plaster and other CSR Gyprock Specialty products release heat (exothermic) when reacting with water. The heat produced by this chemical reaction (setting) of plaster with water is a risk if casting parts of the body.

## Storage

Store plaster in a dry place. Do not place bags directly on concrete floors or damp ground. Long term storage may affect the plaster setting time and finish quality.

## Mixing

Gyprock Casting Plaster can be mixed by hand or with mechanical mixers. A workable mix is normally 65-70 gauge (100 parts plaster with 65-70 parts water by weight). Gyprock Casting Plaster gives maximum strength when it is mixed with a minimum amount of water.

## Application

Moulds should be thoroughly cleaned and coated with a release agent where appropriate. Pour the mixed plaster into moulds and allow adequate time for setting before stripping. When used for the manufacture of fibre-reinforced plaster products, fibreglass rovings are laid into the plaster slurry during caster.

## Installing to Standards

Installing to Standards AS/NZS2589: Gypsum linings – Application and Finishing outlines the procedures for jointing and finishing of Gyprock plasterboard in conjunction with additional details contained in Gyprock Technical Literature.
